The Admin App Review





Django Admin Site

- Site address/admin to login
- Create an admin user: python3 manage.py createsuperuser
- Manage Security and permissions (groups)
- Edit Tables here if in the admin.py file



General Models

- Table name all lower, prefixed by app name
- Supports multiple DB types
- Simple definition and class that can be utilized
- Includes foreign keys, default id primary key



Administer Models

- Admin and Models tie together via names
- Linking to other tables and selectors
- Display, Filters, Search
- Listed on the admin site by application





- Simple Steps
- Modify models.py, maybe admin.py
- Python3 manage.py makemigrations [appname]
- Python3 manage.py migrate
- Model options
